- 4. When different parties control two chambers of a legislature, it is difficult to pass major pieces of legislation.
- 5. If a young person watches a lot of television, he or she will engage in antisocial behavior.
- 6. The severity of punishment has no effect on the amount of violent crime.
- 7. There is a relationship between the amount of political freedom in a nation and the size of the domestic police force.
